Dear Scholarship Applicant:

In preparing your application, please read the instructions carefully. Please type or legibly print the requested information. If the question requires a “Yes” or “No” answer, please circle one. Make sure you provide all submittals requested, as omissions can result in disqualification. All required submittals are listed below and should be used as a “checklist” to make sure your application is complete. Your application should include:

- Application Form.** All requested information must be included.
- High School Transcripts.** The past four (4) years, including grade point average (GPA).
- Essay.** Complete an essay in 500 words or less on one of the topics outlined in the application.
- Academic Recommendations.** At least one (1) and not more than four (4).
- Individual Recommendations.** At least one (1) and not more than four (4).
- Scholarship List.** A list of scholarships, financial aid and grants, including work-study for the coming year.

Make sure your application is delivered by the deadline listed in the General Information form in your packet. Late entries will not be considered. Thank you for your interest.

2017 Community South Scholarship Program

General Information

Purpose:

At Community South, we know the importance of continuing your education, but are also aware the cost continues to rise. That is why we have established a scholarship program to help deserving students with some of those expenses.

For the 2016-2017 school year, the Credit Union will be awarding four \$1,000 scholarships. Scholarship recipients will be notified by May 1, 2017. Please see the Eligibility Guidelines for applicant requirements.

Amount of Scholarships:

Payment of the scholarships will be made in the form of a check payable directly to the school of choice as designated by the recipient.* Recipients must provide proof of registration to receive the scholarship. Scholarship funds must be utilized within 12 months or will be forfeited.

*Some exceptions may apply.

Eligibility Guidelines:

1. Applicant must be a member, or a child or grandchild of a member of Community South Credit Union in good standing.
2. Applicants must be eligible for graduation in 2017 from Holmes, Jackson, or Washington County. Home schooled seniors residing in these counties are also eligible.
3. Applicant must have a minimum high school grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 based upon a 4.0 grading system. A copy of transcripts for the past four (4) years is required.
4. Submit at least one (1) and not more than four (4) academic letters of recommendation from authorities at your school such as teachers, principal, or guidance counselor.
5. Submit at least one (1) and not more than four (4) letters of recommendation from individuals, other than family members, who have known you for at least two (2) years.
6. Applicant must provide an essay in your own words answering one of the following:
 - 1.) "How can credit unions improve to reach a younger market?" or
 - 2.) "The role of "Community South in my family's life and/or community..."The essay should be 500 words or less, written or typed.
7. Completed applications with required submittals should be delivered to the following address no later than the close of business on Wednesday, April 12, 2017.
